The tennis courts at the school needed to be moved to allow room for the school's new expansion project. During times of heavy rainfall the areas around the school would experience water pooling in pedestrian areas.

Project Design Brief

To help with the heavy rainfall, the school wanted to install a proper drainage system, especially in the tennis courts. This would ensure there would be no delayed matches and that the court surface would not degrade prematurely. By running trench drain around the perimeter, the area would quickly drain to prevent further ponding.

Benefits

- ACO KlassikDrain K100 and galvanized steel slotted grates were used to remove water from the courts, be safe for foot traffic, and to add to the style of the tennis courts.
