The Fairfax Fire and Rescue Department is both a career and volunteer organization that serves Fairfax County in Virginia. The department serves the community by providing fire suppression, emergency medical response, fire prevention, and arson investigation services.

Project Design Brief

The FG200 runs along the center of each fire engine bay, collecting water that accumulates during the wash down process of the fire trucks. The drain is located in an area with minimal traffic, allowing for a Load Class E trench drain rather than a Load Class F, making it a cost-effective solution.

Benefits

- FG200 is an 8" (200 mm) internal width fiberglass system comes with a surface mounted steel frame.
- The FG200 system is available in twelve, interconnecting, 9-foot long channels with a built in 1.0% slope.
