In 1991 the United States Air Force moved most of the F-117 Stealth fighters to a new location at Hollomon Air Force Base in New Mexico. For security reasons the Stealth fighters needed to be kept inside hangars whenever possible. All maintenance and refueling, normally done outside, was to

be done inside the hangar. This required 40 specially designed hangars to be built, each with a complete spill containment system around the aircraft in case of fueling and other spills - ACO Drain provided over 11,000 feet of modular, precast trench drainage for the project
