The Tower of the Americas San Antonio, TX

The Tower of the Americas is a 750-foot observation tower-restaurant located in the Hemisfair sector of Downtown San Antonio, Texas. O'Neil Ford, a San Antonio architect, constructed the tower, which served as the theme building for the 1968 World's Fair.

Project Design Brief

The engineers agreed that a trench drain would be required to drain storm water runoff and minimize ponding when developing this new facility, which is especially important given that this is a pedestrian plaza. The FG200 was chosen to provide the required hydraulic performance and to guarantee that all storm water is swiftly evacuated.

Benefits
