During the design of the new University of Colorado Hospital Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora, the Flight for Life transport helicopters helipad was positioned across the street from the emergency department.

To ensure the helipad remains free of standing water and snow melt a trench drain was required. A trench drain would not only effectively drain the area but allowed for simple two-way

grades giving a flatter surface for the helicopter and wheeled stretchers.

FlowDrain FG200 was used as the long 9' lengths ensured a speedy installation. Heavy duty ductile iron grates were used to withstand the loadings from helicopters, ambulances and stretchers.
