Station 10 for Fairfax County Fire & Rescue and Baileys Crossroads Volunteer Fire Department uses four runs of K100 trench drain with heavy duty slotted galvanized steel grates.

Project Design Brief

The trench drain runs down the center of each individual fire engine bay and effectively collects and drains any excess water from washing the trucks, melted ice and snow, and any potential spills.

Benefits

- ACO K100 with slotted galvanized steel grates meets Load Class E requirements.
- Grates can be removed to provide easy access to the channels for inspection and maintenance.
- K100 has a galvanized steel integral rail to protect the channel edge and gives a clean finish against the concrete slab floor.
