During the upgrading and building of new facilities on the campus of Florida State University, the architect decided a trench drain system was needed because of the elevation change throughout the entire site.

#### Project Design Brief

The drainage system would need to be quick and efficient. It would also have to incorporate the design of the area. These areas are heavily trafficked by students, so their safety and comfort was of utmost importance. ACO Drain KlassikDrain KS100 drainage system was chosen because the stainless steel perforated grates would ensure longevity and aesthetic value to the area while meeting all the necessary end user considerations for the students.

#### Benefits

- KlassikDrain has a 0.5% slope inside the channel ensuring water flows to the outlets.
- The grates are heel safe, ADA compliant, and bicycle safe.
