### Mishawaka Riverwalk Mishawaka, IN

The Mishawaka Riverwalk area is being restored because of its historic interest. The Riverwalk was first built in 1833 and was the heart of Mishawaka during World War II.

#### Project Design Brief

Due to the location of the project, a trench drainage system was needed to prevent rainwater run-off from the surrounding hard paving running straight into the river, carrying possible debris with it.

#### Benefits

- ACO's KlassikDrain KS100 with stainless steel grates was selected to alleviate the excess water in the area. The stainless steel edge of the channel makes it ideal to butt the pavers against the side of the channel.
- The locked perforated grate is completely ADA and pedestrian safe and fits aesthetically into the overall design.
