Circuit of The Americas - F1 Race Track Austin, TX

Since 1950, Formula One (F1) has been the world's premier motor racing championship. During that time, many F1 races have been held in the United States, from a road circuit in upstate New York to a street circuit in Long Beach, California, to a race around Caesars Palace's car park.

Project Design Brief

It was announced in 2010 that a new circuit would be built in Austin, Texas, to host US F1 races from 2012 to 2022. Hermann Tilke, a German architect, has spent the last 15 years designing purpose-built circuits for Formula One races. Many of these new circuits feature extensive trench drainage, and the Austin track is no exception.
