Silverstrand Bike Path Imperial Beach, CA

The Silver Strand Bikeway: a stretch of segregated asphalt that follows State Route 75 from the Coronado Yacht Club in the north all the way around the southern tip of the San Diego Bay.

Project Design Brief

During heavy rain, the sloping parking lot - adjacent to the Silverstrand bike path - would direct surface water to the bike path, where it would sit until it evaporated. To fix the problem, the bike path was renovated and ACO's KlassikDrain KS100 with Type 478Q grates system was installed to capture the water run off.

Benefits

- The Type 478Q ADA Compliant grates were specified to allow safe pedestrian access to the scenic outlook areas along the path. The trench drain was located outside the main traffic route and the small openings allow cyclists to pass over the grates without the wheels becoming trapped between the grate slots.
