Project Design Brief

A replacement of an ACO Drain® was needed after some memorial upgrades occurred. A trench drain system is required to remove water and keep the walkways surrounding these iconic monuments safe. The KS100 was chosen for this project because of its adaptability and ability to fit into the aesthetics of the surrounding environment.

Benefits

- The Type 465Q grates by ACO are design to be safe for pedestrians in wheelchairs, high heels, or riding bikes.
