

This Federal Building was built in 1963 and renamed in honor of Abraham Ribicoff in 1980.

Recent refurbishments to provide a new exterior entrance plaza included a new marble façade planter separating the plaza in two, granite pavers, and architectural concrete patio. To ensure the aesthetics of the plaza, a discreet trench drain was required that would not detract from the modernistic beauty of the Ribicoff Federal Building.

ACO Brickslot was selected as an ideal product to use with the granite pavers and when installed at the base of the marble planters, the system is barely visible to the untrained eye. Removable access covers provide access to the channel and pipework for maintenance and cleaning.
