Project Design Brief

The new construction at the United States Institute of Peace building in Washington, D.C. called for a discreet trench drain system for the pedestrian area that would not take away from brick pavers or natural landscape of the area.

Benefits

- Brickslot K100 neutral channel allows it to bend between the paving joint and not distract from aesthetics of the landscape.
- The 3/8" flared slot is discreet and also prevents debris from being trapped and blocking the opening.
