As a part of New York City's "Take The Field" project, Alfred E. Smith High School was undergoing a dramatic renovation to the athletic field and track area. As part of that renovation, ACO Sport's System 2000 was installed to provide discreet drainage without interrupting the visual appearance of the new track and field.

The smooth, flat surface of the slotted system allows track material to be bonded to the trench to

anchor the track surface in place, creating a safe transition across the trench to the field area. System 2000 is manufactured with both straight and radiused channels, meaning less installation time and no on-site fabrications.
