System 4000 with galvanized steel slotted grates



When the new Cleveland Browns NFL Stadium was built, a drainage system was needed to remove both rainwater and wastewater from pressure washing the seating areas. A high capacity and reliable system was required to prevent flooding and damage on the field. ACO Sport System 4000 was used around the entire perimeter of the field, with 600 series catch basins and galvanized steel trash buckets.

Although visually identical, different grates were used around the field. Areas where heavy equipment needs to be moved onto the field, were fitted with a heavy duty grates to avoid vehicular damage.

System 4000 is a 1-30 sloping system with neutrals available in three depths with a choice of grates.
