Project Design Brief

A grated system was required along the straightaways of the track as the field is natural turf and regular mowing creates clipping that would be more easily removed from a grated system. The 'D' areas however would require a slotted system as the areas were used for other athletic disciplines and a slotted wouldn't create any visual distractions for athletes.

Benefits

- The grates are also ADA compliant to ensure the safety of athletes crossing the grates to access the field.
- System 2000 and System 4020 offer similar invert depths for easy installation and transition is simple when done at an in-line catch basin.
- Catch basins are installed at intervals around the track for easy access to aid in the maintenance of the track.
